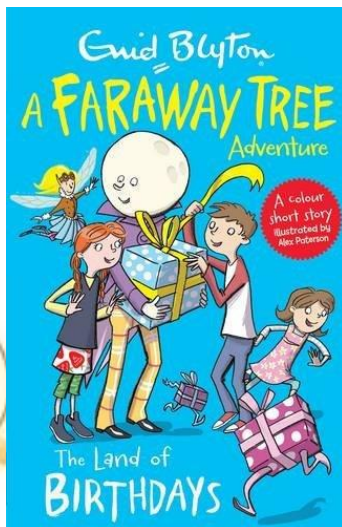
My Favorite Book
